Program Assessment Survey

The Program Assessment Survey was reviewed. Tim Brophy and Theresa Vernetson, who were unable to attend the meeting, had sent suggestedions for revisions that Mark had circulated to the committee. Additional revisions were suggested. Departments need to know that they will be expected to have completed three cycles of the program assessment process by 2014 when SACS carries outcomes for the reaccreditation process. SACS can sample any program as part of their review process; UF will not be able to determine which programs are reviewed -by the site visitors. In order for the survey to serve as a wake_up call to any programs that have not yet begun to collect data, it needs to go out soon. Mark will incorporate the suggestions and send it around for one last review and e_mail approval, after which i—It will then be sent to the dDeans of each college with a request that they forward it to each program. A deadline of four weeks from when the survey goes out will be given. Deans will be asked to summarize what the progress of their programs and provide this information to us along with the survey submitted by each program.
