

Summer Review of Quest Courses for Fall '20

Quest Uber Committee: Selman Hershfield, John Krigbaum, Alison Reynolds, and Brenda Smith of GEC, plus Trysh Travis from QCC

Task: Reviewed all 34 of the courses selected to run in the Quest 1 and 2 curricula in fall of 2020, and bring the syllabuses into full alignment with Quest and Gen Ed specifications as well as UF syllabus policy.

Process:

- Two-person teams worked with each submitter to revise and resubmit syllabuses that had been approved for Quest to get them ready for formal review at the Sept/Oct GEC meetings.
- After that lengthy revision process, a different QUC member did a “Fresh Eyes Review” (FER) to make sure that nothing had been overlooked.
- After passing the FER, submitters received a greenlight to upload their syllabus into the approval.ufl portal.
- The table below is a working document showing the distribution of documents across the committee for the FER, as well as the status of each syllabus on 4 September. (Color coding is for internal purposes and can be ignored.)

Take-away: Unless otherwise noted, a course greenlighted into the approval.ufl portal is believed by the QUC to comply with the published standards of both the UF Syllabus policy and the Gen Ed Syllabus policy as well as, when applicable, the WR Course Syllabus policy.
