**Current Curriculum for Major** Request to modify the model 8 semester plan for the Portuguese track in the HLL major. When major was approved, there was a discrepancy between the proposed critical tracking and the proposed model plan, which we did not realize at the time.

**Proposed Curriculum Changes** The proposed 8-semester model plan now aligns with the critical tracking in the Portuguese track, and also more closely mirrors the model plans for the other tracks within the HLL major.

**Pedagogical Rationale/Justification** Parity within the catalog copy for the major (making sure tracking and model plan align); parity within the different tracks of the major.

**Impact on Enrollment, Retention, Graduation** None. The tracking requirements are the same, and so current students have been advised correctly all along. The proposed change is only to make the model plan fit within the critical tracking requirements.
