The HUM courses are currently being offered by the Arts in Medicine curriculum and have capacity for these certificate students. HUM4594 is under revision and will be submitted to the approval system.

Rationale for Proposed Change(s)

Response:

When the certificate was initially proposed, Music and Health was listed as a special topics course. It now has a permanent course number of HUM3523.

Modifying the HUM4594 course to be 3 credits instead of 1 will create better alignment with the SLO requirements of the certificate.

After completing an in depth certificate map, modifiying the Music in Medicine Capstone course to be 3 credits instead of 1 credit will create alignment with the SLO requirements of the certificate.
