Proposed Changes

Describe the proposed changes to the minor.

Response:

- 1) Allow ARA 2220 and ARA 2221 (Intermediate Arabic 1 and 2) or higher-level courses to satisfy the first tier.
- 2) Combine the second tier (3 credits) and third tier (6 credits) into one tier (9 credits).
- 3) Remove the requirement that the third tier (now second) must exclude language courses.

Pedagogical Rationale/Justification

Describe the rationale for the proposed changes.

Response:

The previous requirements have proven to be unrealistic. To complete the minor, students are required to complete 18 credits of coursework at the beginning and intermediate levels (prereqs - not counted toward the minor) plus 15 credits at the upper levels (counted toward the minor; total: 33 credits. The modified requirements are more realistic as they require students to complete 27 credits of coursework in total:

- 10 credits of ARA 1130-1131 (Beginning Arabic 1&2); these satisfy CLAS Foreign Language Requirement
- 15-17 credits toward the Minor

Heritage learners who test out of Intermediate ARA 2220 (4 credits) and ARA 2221 (4 credits) should take upper level courses - e.g., ARA 3410 (3 credits) and ARA 3411 (3 credits). These students need 15 credits instead of 17 to complete the minor.

The modified requirement follow the Chinese and Japanese model https://catalog.ufl.edu/UGRD/colleges-schools/UGLAS/EAC_EAJ_UMN/ . Like Arabic, Chinese (Mandarin & Cantonese) and Japanese, are classified by the US Department of State as Category IV languages in terms of difficulty for native speakers of English.

Impact on Other Programs

Describe any potential impact on other programs or departments, including increased need for general education or common prerequisite courses, or increased need for required or elective courses outside of the existing program.

Response:

The change may only have a positive impact on the International Studies Major (INS). Students majoring in INS with focus on the Middle East and North Africa are required to complete Intermediate Arabic 1 adn 2. By counting these courses toward the Arabic Minor, students may be motivated to do an additional 9 credits and complete the Minor.

We do not foresee any negative impact.
