Pedagogical Rationale/Justification Universal Tacking of semesters 1-5 includes ARA 1130 Beginning Arabic 1 in Semester 3. In order to design a Universal Tracking that also includes semesters 6-8, we need to move ARA 1130 to Semester 1. This is so because the major requires seven language courses that need to be taken in a sequence. These are ARA1130, 1131, 2220, 2221, 3410, 3411, 4400. Universal Tracking must necessarily include the first course (ARA1130) in Semester 1 in order to be able to accommodate the seventh course (ARA4400) in Semester 7. If a student begins in spring, their ARA1130 will be in their first fall on campus, and their ARA4400 will be in Semester 8.

Impact on Enrollment, Retention, Graduation The change will likely boost retention and graduation as it helps students to plan in advance.

-Students who join UF as Freshman, knowing from the outset that they want to major in FLL-Arabic, they will be on track all the time provided they follow the distribution in the plan.

Students who decide to declare the major at a later stage, they may be off track with regard to the language courses (but not necessarily the content courses). This problem is often solved in one of the following ways:

- (i) Students may take summer language courses at UF, or
- (ii) they may choose to do study abroad.

Either option provides students with the opportunity to do a two-semester worth of coursework over the summer and become on track again. E.g., if a student decides to declare FAR at the end of their freshman year, they may use option (i) or (ii) to cover ARA1130-1131 and get on track. They then do ARA 2220 Intermediate Arabic 1 in their Semester 3 as expected.

Transfer students who join UF in their 5th semester normally follow the following scenario (though our experience is with the minor because the FAR major is new, but the scenario works for both):

- They use option (i) in the summer prior to their 5th semester to do ARA1130-1131 on campus.
- They do ARA2220-2221 in the fall and spring of their Junior year.
- They use option (ii) and do study abroad in the summer of their Junior year to cover ARA3410-3411.

- They come back in their senior year to do ARA4400 as expected.

The major gives students a foundation in the Arabic language, including speaking, reading, writing, and listening, as well as the opportunity to advance their knowledge of Arab cultures. It prepares students for graduate school and is ideal for students considering careers in government and diplomacy, academia, business, and international development. Many students choose to double major in the Arabic specialization of the Foreign Languages and Literatures major and another subject in social sciences, humanities, business, or journalism.

COURSEWORK FOR THE MAJOR

The Arabic specialization of the Foreign Languages and Literatures major consists of preparatory language study at the lower division (1000 and 2000 level), and 33 hours of advanced language, theory, and culture study in the upper division (3000 level and above).

OVERSEAS STUDY

Students of the Arabic specialization of the Foreign Languages and Literatures major are encouraged to study abroad for a summer or a semester. Students may choose the nine-week summer UF-sponsored program in the Arabic Language Institute in Fez (ALIF) in Morocco. The program offers students the opportunity to earn 11 credit hours (only 6 may be transferred as part of the Required Foundation Coursework). More information .

Students may also choose another UF-approved study-abroad program in Morocco or another Arab country (e.g., in Jordan, Qatar).

PLACEMENT

In all languages, students with either a native background in the language or prior study in that language, might be eligible to place out of the preparatory language courses and should meet with the undergraduate coordinator to arrange for placement assessment.

RESEARCH

Students with an upper-division GPA of 3.5 are encouraged to write a thesis for high or highest honors at graduation.
