OTH 6641)

and move the content into three new courses (noted below at OTH 6xxx).

The new courses would be consistent with our curriculum design, which focuses on occupationbased practice in rehabilitation

and how occupation-based practice supports participation and health. Adult-related content in these areas is taught in the fall

and the new courses would teach the child-related content in the spring. Clinical skills for children will be taught in OT Clinical Skills 3.

There is no change in credit hours as the previous 2 courses (OTH 6635 and OTH 6641) are being replaced by the 3 new courses.

Pedagogical Rationale/Justification As part of our self-study, in preparation for accreditation for the Doctor of Occupational Therapy program, the faculty created a new curriculum design that linked the adult rehabilitation, adult participation, and adult clinical skills content to parallel content taught for children and youth. This approach will allow students to more easily link content

from one population, age group, and setting to another across semesters. Our faculty will be able to thread the themes of human occupation and health, critical thinking for practice and scholarship, and psychomotor skills across the curriculum because content will now be linked by similar course objectives, organization, and assignments.

Impact on Enrollment, Retention, Graduation There is no impact since the credit hours will not change by replacing of the old courses (8 credits) with the new courses (8 credits).
