Pedagogical Rationale/Justification Students majoring in composition at New World School of the Arts currently take Applied Instrument Lesson for 1 credit at the upper level over 3 semesters. As a result, they fall short of the 6-credit total Applied Instrument Lesson UF requirement. Summary/Rationale of Proposed Changes:

1) Change Applied Instrument Lesson credits from 3 credits each over 2 semesters, to 1 credit each over 3 semesters at the upper division.

- *Rationale:* Students majoring in composition at New World School of the Arts currently take Applied Instrument Lesson for 1 credit at the upper level over 3 semesters. As a result, they fall short of the 6-credit total Applied Instrument Lesson UF requirement. To correct this, it is proposed to reduce the required credits for Applied Instrument Lessons from 6 to 3 total Applied Instrument Lesson credits.

2) Change the total required elective credits from 12 to 15 credits.

- *Rationale:* Increasing the elective requirements from 12 to 15 ensures that the upper division credit total remains at 60, once the Applied Instrument Lesson requirement is decreased.
