Response:

The proposed changes reflect an update to the structure and course options in the minor which have been in place for many years. The previous structure of the the minor was aligned with our old department structure in the college. The proposed revisions provide students with course options focused on three different aspects of education - education issues and topics, personal learning & reflection, and required engagement in at least one field experience course. Additionally, new course options for students in the minor have become available due to recent changes in college degree programs.
