

Semester six: add MUT3322 (moved from semester eight) and shift MUT3612 and MUT4402 to a "select one"

Semester seven: remove MUT3321 and add MUT3611 and MUT4401 as a "select one" Semester eight: remove MUT3322 and MUT4601 and add MUT3612 and MUT4402 as a "select one"



#### **Pedagogical Rationale/Justification**

#### Response:

The curriculum at present has two courses, MUT 4601 Score Reading and MUT 3322 Scoring for Band and Orchestra, and the two courses in question cover similar material. The area faculty feels that Scoring for Band and Orchestra gives students the opportunity to add advanced arrangements for large ensembles to their portfolios, better preparing them for graduate school or commercial work.


