Pedagogical Rationale/Justification

*Notes for Semester One-

• Musical Theatre Faculty determined that some students have been exposed to fundamentals of dance through their high school or other Musical Theatre experiences and, based on their audition for the program might be placed in a Basic level dance course, rather than a fundamentals dance course.

• Musical Theatre faculty determined that an early introduction of voice and speech training for the actor positively impacts and prepares students for the singing voice classes required later in the curriculum.

• There are 6 semesters of TPP 2250, Song and Dance, required throughout the curriculum. The Musical Theatre Faculty determined that starting the academic artistic experience with an ensemble experience as part of the curriculum benefits the education, training, and overall student experience.

• Shifting Gen Ed Mathematics to a summer semester balances the number of credits take each academic semester and promotes students fulfilling the required 9 summer credits at a Florida university.

*Notes for Semester Two-

• Music Theatre Faculty determined that students enrolling in a course that requires participation in evening lab experiences, such as TPA 2232C, Beginning Costume, is more strategically placed in the Spring semester rather than the Fall semester. The Fall semester is when the students have an opportunity to audition for and participate in the SoTD musical, which conflicts with the lab section of TPA 2232C, Beginning Costume.

• Shifting the State Core Gen Ed to Semester Three balances the credit load in Semester Two and Three.

* Notes on Summer semester -

• Shifting the State Core Mathematic from Semester One to the Summer balances the credit load for the first semester and promotes students to fulfill the required 9 summer credits.

• Shifting the State Core Gen Ed Biological or Physical Sciences from Semester 8 to the

summer allows graduating seniors to focus on taking electives that suits their individual needs as they prepare to enter the profession and it promotes students fulfilling the required 9 summer credits.

Notes for Semester Three-

• With the addition of a specialized instructor of Broadway Dance Styles and Tap, the model 8semester plan specifies the dance course from any "approved" course to a course specific to the needs of majors.

• With the addition of specified dance courses for Musical Theatre students, TPP 2282 has been designated as an elective within the major, rather than a required class.

• Faculty determined that moving the MVV1411 Voice class from Semester Eight to Semester Three provides a stronger foundation to the students' singing skills and provides an opportunity to enroll in the class in a later semester as an elective, based on student skill set and schedule.

• Music Theatre Faculty determined that students enrolling in a course that requires participation in evening lab experiences, such as TPA 2232C, Beginning Costume, is more strategically placed in the Spring semester rather than the Fall semester. The Fall semester is when the students have an opportunity to audition for and participate in the SoTD musical, which conflicts with the lab section of TPA 2232C, Beginning Costume.

• Shifting the State Core Gen Ed to Semester Three balances the credit load in Semester Two and Three.

Note for Semester Four-

• With the addition of a specialized instructor of Broadway Dance Styles and Tap, the model 8semester plan specifies the dance course from any "approved" course to a course specific to the needs of majors.

*Notes for Semester Five-

• MUT 1121 for 3 credits is now MUT 1111 Theory 1 (lecture, 2 credits) and MUT 1241L Aural Skills 1 (1 credit). If one places in MUT 1111 they are expected to be MUT 1241L at the same time so MUT 1241L (aural 1) is a co-req for MUT 1111 (Theory 1). The change of MUT 1121 for MUT 1111 and MUT 1241L updates the curriculum to reflect course changes in the School of Music.

• With the addition of a specialized instructor of Broadway Dance Styles and Tap, the model 8semester plan specifies the dance course from any "approved" course to a course specific to the needs of majors. The change reflects the requirement of 1 semester of Tap.

• Faculty determined that TPP 2250 Song and Dance is required for 6 semesters and the ensemble experience that provides for a variety of singing experiences is addressed in those 6 credits; the additional TPP or MUN ensemble credit is unnecessary as a requirement but can be taken as an elective.

*Notes for Semester Six -

• With the addition of a specialized instructor of Broadway Dance Styles and Tap, the model 8semester plan specifies the dance course from any "approved" course to a course specific to the needs of majors. The change reflects the requirement of 1 semester of Tap.

• Shifting the Electives from Semester Six to Semester Eight balances the credit load and allows seniors to take electives in the major that can be tailored to their specific professional goals after graduation.

*Note for Semester Seven----

• If a student took DAA 1000 (3 cr.) in Semester One, they need to complete 4 elective credits. If a student took an approved Basic Dance Course (2 cr), the need to complete Gen Ed Humanities for 3 credits and 2 elective credits.

• Faculty determined that moving the MVV1411 Voice class from Semester Eight to Semester

Three provides a stronger foundation to the students' singing skills and provides an opportunity to enroll in the class in a later semester as an elective, based on student skill set and schedule.

• The replacement of the Historic Costume or History of Architecture Class with a survey class of the American Musical, History of Jazz, or a survey of Pop Music in the USA class provides students with set of courses that are degree and career specific.

• The Musical Theatre Faculty determined that starting the academic artistic experience with an ensemble experience as part of the curriculum benefits the education, training, and overall student experience; for this reason TPP2250, Song and Dance, has been moved to Semester One.

• Shifting the State Core Gen Ed Biological or Physical Sciences from Semester 8 to the summer allows graduating seniors to focus on taking electives that suits their individual needs as they prepare to enter the profession and it promotes students fulfilling the required 9 summer credits.

• Shifting the Electives from Semester Six to Semester Eight balances the credit load and allows seniors to take electives in the major that can be tailored to their specific professional goals after graduation.

- Shifting the State Core Gen Ed Biological or Physical Sciences from Semester 8 to the summer allows graduating seniors to focus on taking electives that suits their individual needs as they prepare to enter the profession and it promotes students fulfilling the required 9 summer credits.
