- 1. **Update on Pilot Survey** Dr. Hanson reported that the IRB2 proposal was turned in by the deadline and thanked everyone for their efforts. She explained the IRB2 meeting is December 9<sup>th</sup> so hopefully we will receive a positive result to be able to distribute to the faculty. She explained that in the IRB2 proposal, she included the content of an e-mail that will introduce the survey to the faculty prior to reading the consent form. We will discuss these and other item ideas on December 17<sup>th</sup>.
