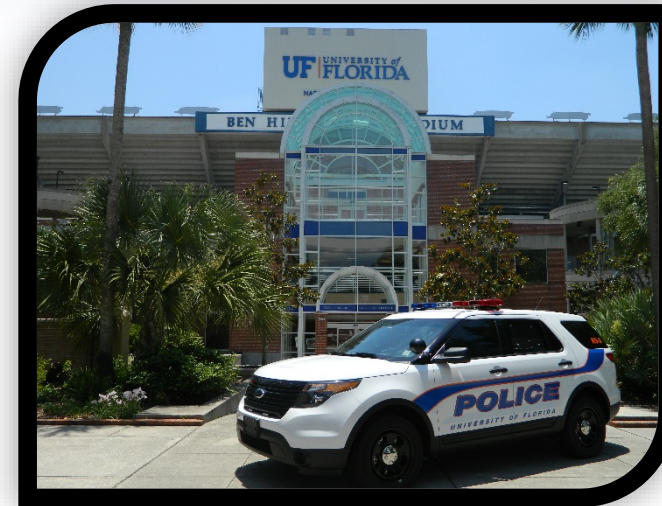

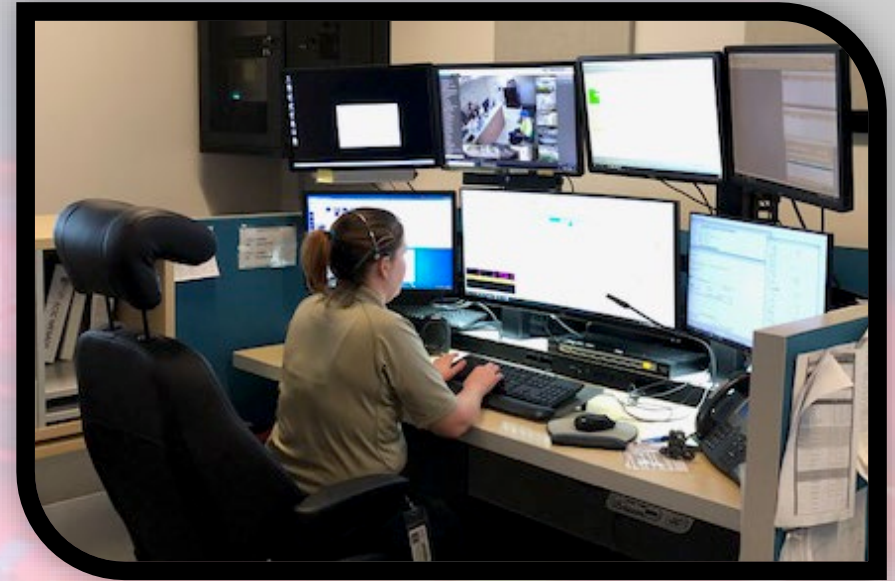

- Implements Threat Mitigation Practices

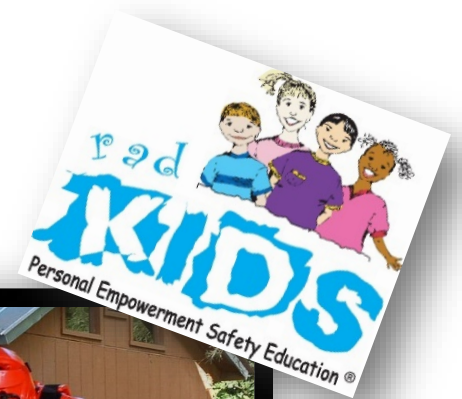

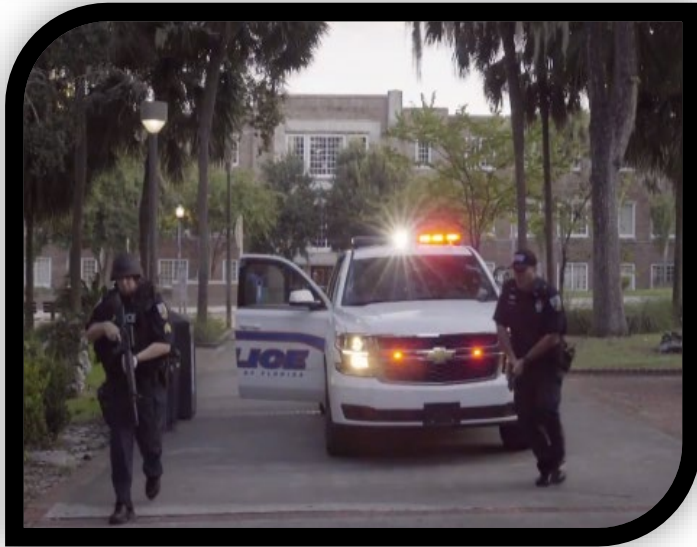
# Emergency Planning Cohort

# Response to Active Shooter



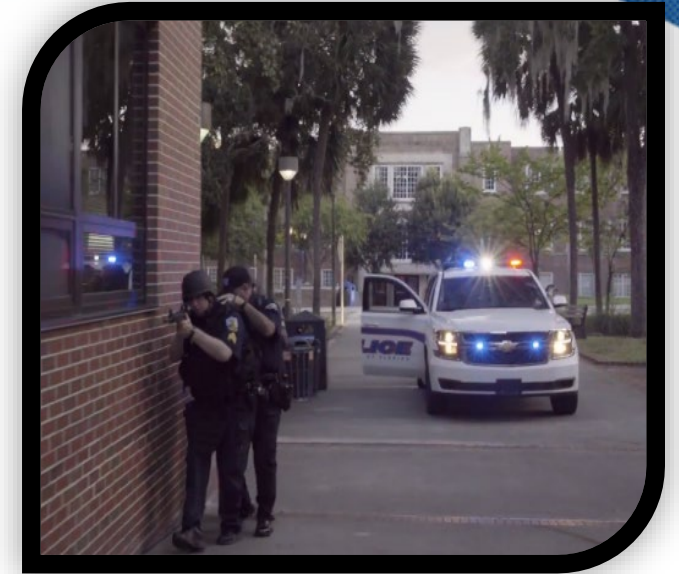
## Annual Training

All UFPD Officers receive annual training for Active Shooter Situations



## Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT)

15 Officers comprise specialized team who train monthly for active shooter situations with specialized equipment



## Rifled Officers

30 officers qualified to carry rifles designed to engage and stop an active shooter situation
