Known as BCT


- Multidisciplinary Team which reviews threats to campus community

Annual Training

All UFPD Officers receive annual training for Active Shooter Situations



Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT)

15 Officers comprise specialized team who train monthly for active shooter situations with specialized equipment



Rifled Officers

30 officers qualified to carry rifles designed to engage and stop an active shooter situation
