

Compensation Committee

University Constitution Article V (4)(D)

The Compensation Committee shall have six faculty members who shall represent a broad range of academic disciplines and units. The members shall be elected by the Faculty Senate from the Faculty at large to staggered three-year terms. The committee shall elect its own chair. The committee shall have one administrative representative appointed by the President **or the President's designee** to serve as a liaison able to provide the required information to carry out the committee's responsibilities. The committee shall evaluate ~~and report on compensation relative to peer institutions, raise results and salary structures at the University, and make recommendations with respect to raise procedures at the University.~~ **matters of compensation including, but not restricted to, salary and benefits. Its agenda is established in conjunction with the Welfare Council to which it reports.**
