**CLASSROOM AIR
EXCHANGE DATA**

All air handling unit design for UF buildings is based on ASHRAE (American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers) standards. A process to calculate and evaluate ACH (Air Change per Hour) levels has been conducted by Facilities Services staff. ACH as defined by ASHRAE is calculated as ventilation airflow divided by room volume, and it indicates how many times, during one hour, the air volume from a space is replaced with outside air.

Rooms identified as instructional spaces with completed assessments will display their calculated ACH below. For spaces where measurements and calculations are still being completed "Unknown ACH" will be displayed. As additional assessments are completed that data will be added to this page.
