NOTE: Students in the Spanish, Portuguese or combined tracks can choose to specialize in either linguistics or literature. Both emphasize the same degree of cultural knowledge and proficiency in written and spoken language but focus on different content. The SPN and POR classes deal with linguistic and scientific aspects of the Spanish and Portuguese languages, such as phonetics, phonology, syntax, morphology, and theories of language acquisition and change; while the SPW and POW classes analyze literary works and other cultural products of various genres, regions and periods.

Content Knowledge								SLOs are assessed continually throughout coursework, but formally through a rubric-evaluated assignment, which is included or made available in all 4000-level courses. Assignment topics are generally course-specific but all include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the written analysis of a Spanish and/or Portuguese text or dataset (collected by student or provided by faculty or corpora); • an exploration in the paper of that analysis according to its cultural, literary and/or linguistic content; • an oral presentation in Spanish/Portuguese of the main topics of that written paper in front of the class or another comparable audience; • discussion conducted in Spanish/Portuguese about the topic with questions and answers lasting no fewer than 10 minutes (from faculty and students)
