It appears that the courses for the certificate have not been approved. Please resubmit when the courses are approved. 2. The scale for the rubric was a point of discussion. The committee had no problem with 90-100% as being completely/correctly addressed, but the scale of 1- 90% as partially addressed was questioned. First, the two ranges overlap - 90% exists in both ranges. Second, it's not clear how the range of 1-90% will discriminate meaningfully among levels of student performance; also this wide range calls into question the value of the "non/incompletely addressed" level, which will be at 0% only. Please revise this once the courses are approved and the rubric is revised to clarify the distinct levels of performance on the rubric provided.
