Response:

The plan was modified to reflect a different goal and the removal of formative feedback from the assessment methods for the three SLOs in the plan. The goal was changed from "increasing enrollment" to "providing an effective curriculum" as students in this online certificate program can enter the program and are allowed to complete the courses as their personal schedules allow. Tracking enrollment doesn't accurately reflect the actual enrollment at any given time. Providing a curriculum that helps students develop the knowledge, skills, and attitudes of shelter medicine professionals is the ultimate goal. Changing the goal also required a change in the evaluation method. We intend to use end of course student feedback for this. The assessment method for the three SLOs included formative student surveys, which the program does not gather. This language was eliminated from the assessment method for each of the SLOs.

The revised language for the Program Goal includes a title change to "Effective Curriculum" and a goal statement of "Deliver a curriculum that prepares students for careers in shelter medicine." The evaluation method is "Track end of course student feedback surveys."

The revised language for all three SLOs' assessment methods eliminates the use of formative feedback but retains criterion-referenced assessments and summative feedback.

The Detail was also revised to reflect the change in the use of end of course student feedback as the evaluation method for the new program goal.
