

General Education and Writing Requirement with Rotating Topic Courses

1. Current Practice

- When courses are scheduled with the Registrar's Office, non-Rotating Topic courses that are joined to a rotating topic course in a particular semester can donate their Writing Requirement or General Education designation to Rotating Topic course sections with which they are joined
- Rotating Topic courses that have General Education or Writing Requirement designations can donate that designation to permanent course numbers they are joined to in a particular semester
- While there may now be a higher level of scrutiny for this type of approval through the General Education Committee, there are Rotating Topic courses that are currently active that have General Education and/or Writing Requirement designation that were previously approved (see below)

2. Questions for Consideration

- Should there be a policy or procedure for General Education Committee approval of rotating topic courses for such designations?
- What circumstances would allow for approval of this type of request?
- Should Rotating Topic courses be able to donate their General Education or Writing Requirement designations to permanent course numbers when joined to sections in a particular term?
- Should they be able to donate their designations to other rotating topic courses when joined to sections in a particular term?
