The Internationalization Task Force met on Friday afternoon and discussed the SLOs. With the three SLOs below, I shared your recommendation to consider them again, particularly SLO 2 and SLO 3. We also examined the UF Institutional Definitions through the General Education Assessment Plan (also below). After an extensive discussion, the Task Force felt strongly that the current form of the SLOs with reference to the Gen Ed definitions were accurate and met the criteria from Tim's office, particularly the third point of Concision.

Please let me know if this would work for the Gen Ed committee with the reference to the Gen Ed Definitions.

SLO 1. Students identify, describe, and explain global and Intercultural conditions and interdependencies.

SLO2: Students think critically to interpret global and intercultural issues.

SLO3: Students communicate effectively with members of other cultures

Gen Ed Definitions:

Communication: Communication is the development and expression of ideas in written and oral forms.

Critical Thinking: Critical thinking is characterized by the comprehensive analysis of issues, ideas, and evidence before accepting or formulating an opinion or conclusion.
