The guests were introduced and a brief history of the assessment efforts performed in 2003 with the creation of Academic Learning Compacts and Student Learning Outcomes was given by Andy McCollough. Not only were all the Colleges/Programs responsible for assessing these with respect to content knowledge, critical thinking and communications skills, but the General Education Committee also identified assessment rubrics for each of the General Education areas. The specific results of these efforts were to be gathered and reported. Several different assessment tools for General Education have been reviewed with no conclusion. The Chair of the Academic Assessment Committee (AAC), Mark Law, stated the efforts must have faculty by-in and faculty must be able to identify the benefits of their effort. Volunteers for a sub-committee from the gen ed members was requested to work on the assessment efforts with one member designated as liaison to the AAC.
