Chair's Report

- Reminder to the committee that more nominations are needed for councils and committees.

- We have one confirmed presenter for the Distinguished Professor Lecture Series and planning is continuing.

President's Report

President Fuchs gave a short report on the legislature and governor. He distributed the January 14, 2016 Gainesville Sun Editorial and also a graph from the Florida Research Consortium for the committee's information.

 During the past fiscal year (FY15), the foundation broke \$300M in donations. This year (FY16) we have already passed \$200M in six months.

Provost's Report

Joe Glover, Provost

- Provost Glover reminded the committee of the January 28 and 29th Strategic Goals symposium.
- The current university learning management system is a homegrown, 30 years old and • outdated. Within the next three to four years, UF will be converting to the People Soft student module.
- Search Committee will soon choose three finalists and an alternate for the Vice President of Students Affairs position.

Early Council Reports

- Budget Council James Seale, Chair
 - Budget council has had many topics to discuss. For the past year and a half, the council has worked with Greg Dubois on the new Budget Template which will soon come online.
 - Discussed the budget aspect of UF Online at the last meeting with Director Evangeline Cummings.
 - Council will next look into IDCs in February. Some colleges are rejecting grants that have no IDC's because the RCM model requires 10% to be paid to DSP regardless of subsidization of IDC within the proposal.
 - Dr. Seale (as chair of Budget Council) was invited to sit on the RCM Committee.

- Research and Scholarship Council Valrie Minson, Chair
 - o Stephanie Gray explained the difference between two different IDC systems
 - The university will subsidize "non-corporate" groups who do not pay IDCs, but will not subsidize "corporate" entities that do not offer IDCs. PIs can work with DSP on budget development to ensure the request for IDC is included in the proposal.
 - The RCM model requires 10% of IDC to be paid, regardless of subsidization of IDC within the proposal.
 - The council is looking into attending the Research Deans meeting.

• Lynne Palmer and Katie Rogers from the Reitz Union were excited about the Reitz Union's new addition and renovations. They gave a short explanation on their presentation at the Faculty Senate meeting. They also distributed pictures of the new renovations.
