Parking & Transportation Committee. The Parking Transportation Committee consists of 14 members, seven elected by the Senate from the faculty at large, seven faculty or staff appointed by the President's designee, and five student members. The Chair is elected. This committee reviews and recommends rules and regulations of a non-financial nature governing traffic, parking and registration of vehicles, bicycles, scooters and motorcycles and public transportation to and on the campus. It reviews and recommends programs to meet and enhance the parking and transportation on the campus. It reviews and recommends special parking requests from University departments, students, staff and faculty. It reviews and recommends any significant findings regarding all parking and transportation matters. It reports to the Vice President for Finance and Administration the significant findings of the Committee regarding all parking and transportation matters considered by the Committee.
