Since its inception, the TERM program has experienced a dramatic increase in interest, particularly in the Event Management Specialization. There is a growing demand for event management courses on campus as evidenced by the enrollment of 61% (n=70) of non-TERM majors in HFT 2750 Event Management fall 2016. Of the 61% of non-TERM majors, 24 are Business Administration, 20 are Sport Management, 13 are Journalism, 9 are Liberal Arts & Sciences, 3 are Agricultural, 1 is Fine Arts and 1 is Health Education Behavior. In addition to the growing student demand for event management courses, the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics reports a 10% employment growth rate

in the event industry (http://www.bls.gov/ooh/business-and-financial/meetingconvention-and-event-planners.htm, October 25, 2016), resulting in a solid career path for UF students. The documented interest in event management from non-TERM majors and the projected growth of the event industry supports the need for a Minor in Event Management.

The establishment of the Minor in Event Management aims to provide students with access to programming that would otherwise not be extended to them, enriching their majors in other colleges, schools, departments and programs across campus. The Event Management Minor enhances student knowledge of event management and increases their understanding of the practical skills necessary for successful event industry careers. The Minor in Event Management cannot be obtained through any other college, school, department or program within the University of Florida. The only majors prohibited from enrolling in the Minor in Event Management are TERM majors because the minor heavily overlaps with their major area of study. The Minor in Event Management leverages existing TRSM courses, eliminating the need for new course development or the addition of new faculty to support the program.
