Rationale and Place in Curriculum In 2011, the School of Art and Art History added a 3 credit lower division Non-Western Art History course to the UF History of Art minor curriculum and increased the required credits to 18. Up to that time, students at the New World School of the Arts who wanted a minor in Art History simply took the same minor. However, with this change that became impossible. The extra course, Non-Western Art, is not taught at NWSA, and the NWSA students already have a difficult time completing their lower division requirements without the addition of a new course. Because of this, COTA has routinely waived the additional credits for NWSA students. However, with the advent of the BOG requiring that all NWSA's degree programs and minor programs match the hours required for UF/COTA's programs, this is no longer possible. After consultation with NWSA, which was never done in the first curriculum change, NWSA has decided that the best path for them is to create a "new", NWSA specific minor that follows the curriculum of the pre-2011 UF History of Art minor.

Impacts on Other Programs If the new minor code is required to appear on the minor application, the only issue may be some confusion for students applying for the minor, as to which minor code applies to them (this happens with admissions applicants as well, as the degree codes for UF and NWSA are also the same, but this is worked out internally by COTA and its departments). That would mean that there will have to be some monitoring of this by both COTA and the School of Art and Art History to ensure the correct code has been selected. If the new code is not required to appear on the minor application, then the COTA Academic Coordinator can easily modify the form used by NWSA students to ensure that the NWSA specific minor is chosen. COTA is of course happy to consult also with the Office of the University Registrar to determine how to handle the NWSA specific applications to ensure that this process will cause no additional work on their end.
