Course Description A broad history of Greece during WWII, including the German occupation of Greece, the resistance movement in Greece, and the fate of Greece immediately following the end of WWII.

Prerequisites Sophomore standing or higher

Co-requisites None

Rationale and Placement in Curriculum This is the only course available that explicitly looks at Greece during WWII. The course provides a broad overview of Greece during WWII, including the rise of fascism in Europe and Greece, the outbreak of the war, Greek forces in WWII, German occupation of Greece and the fate of Greece in the immediate years after the war.

Course Objectives By the end of the course, students will be able to:

Discuss the role of Greece in the key events and outcomes of WWII

Identify the major events in Greek history between 1930-1950 and its relation to wider European history at that time.

Analyze the role of the Allies and US in the development and modernization of the Greek economy and society at the end of WWII
