Subject: Shift of Undergraduate Economics Courses

As you know, effective July 1, 2014 the Economics Department moved to the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. As part of this move, it is the intent of the Warrington College of Business Administration and the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences that all undergraduate economics courses with a prefix of ECO, ECP, or ECS be part of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. As such, the following language is proposed for consideration at the next University Curriculum Committee meeting.

*Beginning Summer B '14, all undergraduate courses with an ECO, ECP, or ECS prefix are part of the Economics Department in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.*

*Beginning with the '15-'16 undergraduate catalog, all courses with an ECO, ECP, or ECS prefix will be listed under the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.*
