SUBJECT: Update to the Common Prerequisite Manual for the Accounting Major

In 2011, the University Curriculum Committee approved changes to the degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Accounting. One of those changes included adding ACG 2071 to the curriculum, and to make completion of this course one of the critical tracking requirements. It has recently come to our attention that the Common Prerequisite Manual (CPM) was not updated to reflect the need for transfer students to take ACG 2071 prior to admission.

As you can see by looking at the Accounting program in the CPM, ACG 2071 is a standard prerequisite required by most state universities. However, there is also the following footnote:

"At FSU, UF, and USF, ACGX071 will count toward the degree as elective credits for transfer students. However, it is recommended that native students take another non-accounting elective."

Since Fall 2011, this has not been true at UF, since ACG 2071 is required for all students to complete the accounting major. Since the curriculum change was already approved by the UCC and has been reflected in the Undergraduate Catalog since 2011, we hope approval of this change to the CPM will be just a formality for the UCC.
