There is a severe shortage of school-based agricultural educators coupled with the state's requirement for individuals who hold a bachelor of science degree to enter teaching agriculture on a temporary teaching certificate. There is no known overlap with any other existing minors as no minor focuses on agricultural education in public schools.

Impacts on Other Programs

Response:

There are no known negative impacts to degree programs in other departments as the coursework required for this minor is housed in the same department. A positive impact is the broadening of potential employment in agricultural education to CALS students in other majors.

The agricultural curriculum & development minor supplements a student's academic major and prepares students for careers in school-based agricultural education and other agricultural outreach programming. The minor offers course work in formal educational methods, curriculum design, and program planning for youth programs.

With adviser and teacher education coordinator approval, all undergraduates in the college are eligible for this minor. Students in other colleges can also enroll with approval of the Department of Agricultural Education and Communication.
