1. **Approval of minutes of the February 8, 2005 meeting:** The minutes were approved.
2. **Proposed name change for Graduate Engineering Research Center:** Cammy Abernathy proposed a name change for the Graduate Engineering Research Center (GERC) at Eglin Air Force Base. The proposed name is Emerald Coast Research and Engineering Education Facility (REEF). The name change is part of an effort to update the image of the program as it initiates a new growth and business plan. A motion to approve the proposed change was made and seconded. Motion passed.
