1. **Approval of minutes of the September 5, 2006 meeting:** The minutes were approved.
2. **Proposed minor in Religious Ethics:** Yumiko Hulvey proposed a new minor in religious ethics. A motion was made to approve the new minor. Motion passed.
3. **Proposed elimination of the Quantitative Sciences concentration in Interdisciplinary Studies:** Yumiko Hulvey proposed the elimination of this concentration. Students currently in the concentration will be allowed to complete their studies. A motion was made to approve the elimination of this program. Motion passed.
4. **Proposed change in requirements for Public Health minor:** Stephanie Hanson presented a proposal modifying the requirement for the public health minor. A motion was made to approve the change. Motion passed.
5. **Proposed name change for department of Decision and Information Science:** Andy McCollough presented a proposal to change the name of the department of Decision and Information Science to Information Systems and Operations Management. A motion was made to approve the proposed department name change. Motion passed. This item has been forwarded to the Faculty Senate for their review and consideration.
6. **Proposed change to the Gordon Rule Writing requirement:** Andy McCollough reviewed the proposed revision to the current Gordon Rule Writing requirement developed by the General Education Council. All members are asked to solicit feedback from their department faculty. This proposal is also currently being reviewed by the Faculty Senate Academic Policy council. A formal motion to approve the recommendation will be put forth at a future meeting.
7. **Proposed change in requirements for Basic Science and Biology Education specializations for Bachelor of Science in Entomology and Nematology:**

Elaine Turner proposed a modification to the course requirements for these specializations. A motion was made to approve the changes. Motion passed.
