- 1. Approval of minutes of February 16, 2010 meeting.**
The minutes were approved as modified to clarify items 7 and 8.

- 3. Proposed new Environmental Geosciences track, effective Summer B 2010.**
Joann Mossa and Joe Meert presented this plan for a new track that will be offered through both Geology and Geography. The proposal was tabled so additional consultations could be conducted with potentially affected departments.
- 4. Proposed new department of Linguistics, effective Summer B 2010.**
Caroline Wiltshire explained that this program has evolved to function as a department, and they are asking for it to be formally designated as such. The proposal was approved and will be forwarded to the Faculty Senate for consideration.
- 5. Proposed revision to the Entomology and Nematology minor, effective Summer B 2010.**
Dr Turner reviewed this proposal, which will increase the flexibility related to this minor. The changes were approved, pending the addition of language to clarify that courses towards the minor must be at the 3000 level or higher.
- 6. Proposed revision and name change to Organizational Leadership for Nonprofits minor, effective Summer B 2010.**
This proposal was tabled by the committee in October and is being revisited with clarification requested related to the international component and grade points. The proposal was approved, pending a modification to indicate the student must earn "at least 17 hours in the minor".
- 7. Proposed Changes to the Fitness/Wellness Curriculums, effective Summer B 2010.**

Dr Brown explained that this change specifies the chemistry and biology courses that are required for the students to remain on track in their track. The proposal was approved.

Michael Perri presented this joint proposal between the Colleges of Medicine and Public Health and Health Professions that will sunset the existing departments of Epidemiology and Biostatistics in PHHP, create 2 new joint departments in their place and rename the existing department of Epidemiology and Health Policy (in Medicine) the department of Health Outcomes. This proposal was approved and will be forwarded to the Faculty Senate for consideration.
