Minutes of the Meeting of the University Curriculum Committee March 15, 2011

1. Approval of minutes of February 15, 2011 meeting.

Minutes were approved as written.

2. Update from Faculty Senate.

The committee was informed that the proposal to form an Engineering School of Sustainable Infrastructure and the Environment was tabled at the Faculty Senate.

3. Proposed cancelation of Creative Photography major and reinstatement of Creative Photography emphasis in Art major, effective Summer 2011. Dr Schaefer

This cancelation and reinstatement was approved.

4. Proposed creation of Bachelor of Arts in International Studies major, effective Fall 2011. Dr Pharies

This request was explained by David Pharies and Milagros Pena as a needed major pointed out by the most recent SACS review as well as student demand. David Sammons fully supported the request and verified that the Study Abroad office can accommodate the potential increased demand. The request was conditionally approved contingent upon correcting small, technical errors on the forms. The corrections will be done with Dr Mair before submitting to the Faculty Senate.

5. Proposed revision to the Plant Science major, effective Summer B 2011. Dr. Turner

The request would bring several plant sciences tracks under one major rather than duplicating similar courses in several departments. Peggy Carr voiced concern over the Landscape Design specialization and the request was tabled for consultation with Landscape Architecture.

6. Proposed name change of Digital Media program to Art and Technology, effective Summer 2011. Dr. Schaefer

Several concerns were discussed regarding the use of the term technology in this title. Historically "technology" was used to designate hands on experience in a two year college. There were also questions regarding why this change is being made and whether or not this will provide better marketing or value to the program. The request was returned to the college so these concerns could be addressed.

7. Proposed creation of Sustainability and the Built Environment minor, effective Fall 2011. Dr. Carr

This proposal was approved.

8. Proposed creation of pre-public health track in Health Science Program, effective Fall 2011. Dr. Hanson

There was substantial discussion regarding this proposal. Kelly McCormack Brown raised concerns about possible overlap between this track and the Health Education & Behavior major in Health & Human Performance. Dr Brown also raised concerns over growth of the proposed track and would request monitoring and limitation of the growth. Stephanie Hanson discussed the focus of the proposed track was different from the major in HHP and is intended for students planning to go to graduate and professional schools only. Bernard Mair noted that colleges themselves have significant overlap. It was proposed and approved to table the request pending review by a smaller group (Drs Mair, Koro-Ljungberg, Hanson, Brown, and Rush) to meet to discuss the issue further and propose a recommendation to the full committee.
