24. Rationale and Placement in Curriculum

This will continue to be the capstone experience/course for TCH specialization students in the Agricultural Education and Communication major. The requested changes in the course title and description will allow for more accurate reporting related to teacher certification to the College of Education, the Florida Department of Education, and the Educator Accountability System. The course description clarifies that this course is only for school-based student teaching internships, which will provide the basis for subsequent reporting to university, college, and state offices for agriculture teacher certification in grades 6-12. The College of Education supports these clarifications, and a support letter will be presented as needed.
