Impact on Program: The proposed change to the Certificate name and revision to the description will clarify the program within the full menu of Center for Arts in Medicine academic offerings, specifically differentiating it from the graduate certificates and aligning it in name with the Center's other offerings. The updated description provides clarity in relation to the available focus on community-based programming within the Certificate program.

Rationale for Proposed Change(s): The Center for Arts in Medicine recently rebranded from the Center for Arts in Healthcare to the Center for Arts in Medicine and implemented a set of new graduate programs, including the MA in Arts in Medicine, the Graduate Certificate in Arts in Medicine and the Graduate Certificate in Arts in Public Health. The proposed name change aligns the Center's undergraduate certificates in name with the Center and the graduate programs, and also differentiates the

undergraduate certificates from the graduate certificates by adding "undergraduate" to the title. Additionally, our field has moved away from use of the term "healthcare", so we feel that this name will make the certificate more relevant and useful in the job market to the students who earn it.
