It also encourages students with no Spanish background to take the Beginning Sequence earlier so they are more likely to complete their degrees in a timely fashion. Because Beginning Spanish 1 does not have to be completed until the second term, major changers into Spanish in the first and second year still have ample opportunity to get on track, especially if they enroll in Summer classes.
