Proposed Changes We would like to require students who apply for the minor to have completed no more than 2 of the minor courses.

Pedagogical Rationale/Justification Many students discover this minor after having completed all courses, and then apply for the minor. This is antithetical to the desire (clearly stated on our website in the application information): "...the intention of this minor is to choose an Arts curriculum that has a preconceived cohesive program of study that will be supplementary or complementary to the student's educational objectives and career goals, not to assemble a minor from Arts courses that were previously taken by a student with no preconceived intention of creating such a supplementary/complementary curriculum." By requiring students to take at least 9 credits of the minor after applying, we will minimize confusion and better prepare students to develop a successful minor proposal.

No more than 6 credits of the proposed curriculum may be completed prior to applying for the minor.
