Promotion and Tenure

Honorary Degree Request

Dr. Glover explained to the Council that the University does not have a policy in place for awarding degrees to students posthumously. In practice, if a student has finished 75% of their course work, the university will award a degree; however, what happens if the student has only been going to the University for less than a year? Dr. Glover asked the Council if it will research and come up with an recommendation.
