## Faculty Options for Student Incivility – Mary Kay Carodine, Assistant VP for Student Affairs

- Mary Kay Carodine reported on what the university has in place for student incivility
  - [Helping Student in Distress Resource](#) Information which includes FAQs on disruptive or disturbing students.
  - Suggestion: Add definition on classroom behavior to syllabus
  - Outside the classroom, students have a right to say what they wish.
  - Faculty can ask the student to leave the classroom. If they do ask a student to leave, faculty should report this to their chair.
- Patricia Sohn stated that she states her expectations of students in her classroom.
- Suggestions on what “not” to do.
  - Do not touch the student
  - Do not take student’s cell phone
  - Do not block the door.
- Angel Kwolek-Folland and Angela Lindner offered to write a draft on practicalities and academic expectations for APC to review.

## UCC report – Hans van Oostrom, Chair UCC

- The UCC is revising its responsibilities and is unclear about approving 5000 level courses. The committee is continuing to discuss.
