Dean's Survey of RCM Impacts on Interdisciplinary Teaching

Marc has heard from 13 out of the 16 deans. Responses from the deans show that many of the colleges are still operating in silos and confirms past council discussions. The interdisciplinary "Good Life Course" funds are distributed by the Provost. Matt Fajack noted that the RCM manual and Budget Book are posted on his website.
