- How much does it cost to publish in open access?

- What about the legal aspects when journal articles are posted to the web?
- It was pointed out that currently most of open access is with electronic journals.
- Many organizations fund their journals through memberships and memberships are declining.

The council will work on the budget template at April's meeting. April will be the last meeting for this academic year. The open access discussion will continue next fall. Plans are to invite someone from the Library who has knowledge about the budget aspects of open access.
