Inflow side of RCM

- Matt Fajack gave a presentation on Introduction to Tax System in RCM at UF.
 - First the university figures out how much is needed for support units that tend to general little or no revenue, but do incur costs. Support centers explain their value and services to a Budget Review Council that is composed of representatives from colleges, VP areas, and faculty senate. Their costs are allocated to each Responsibility Center based on certain cost drivers. Support centers also go through a "zero-based" budget review every five years. Centers that are up for review this year are: Provost Office, International Studies, Treasure, Bursar and Sustainability.
 - Purpose is to let a college run itself and provide services
 - Library was the hardest hit by the recession
