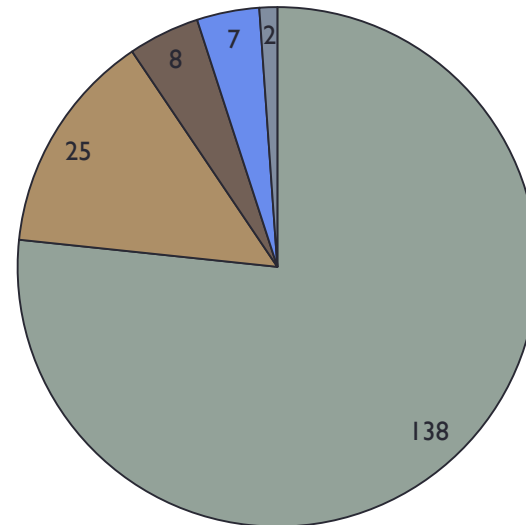

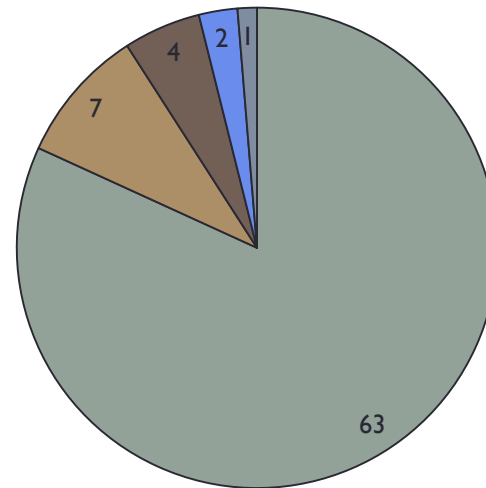

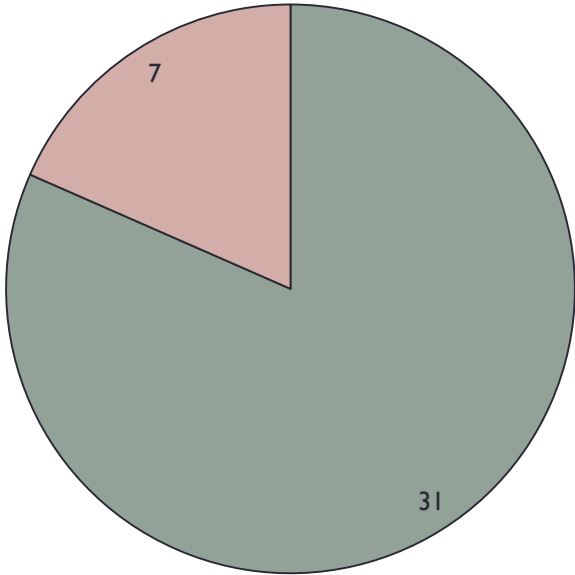

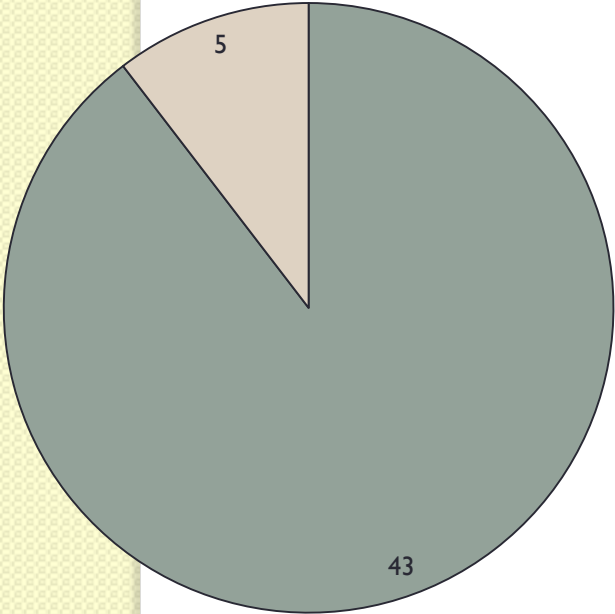

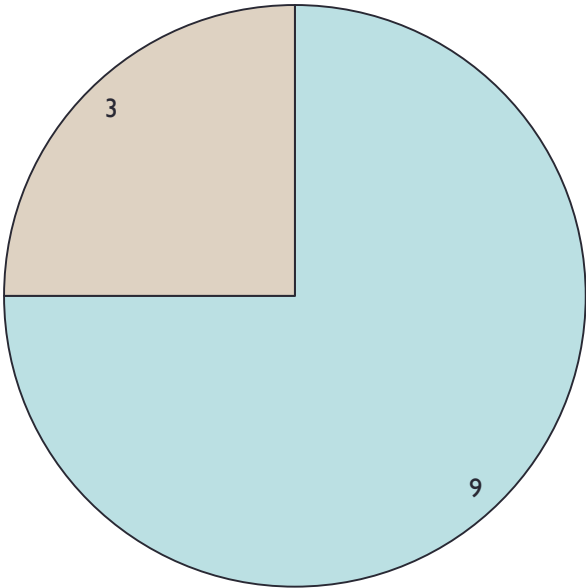

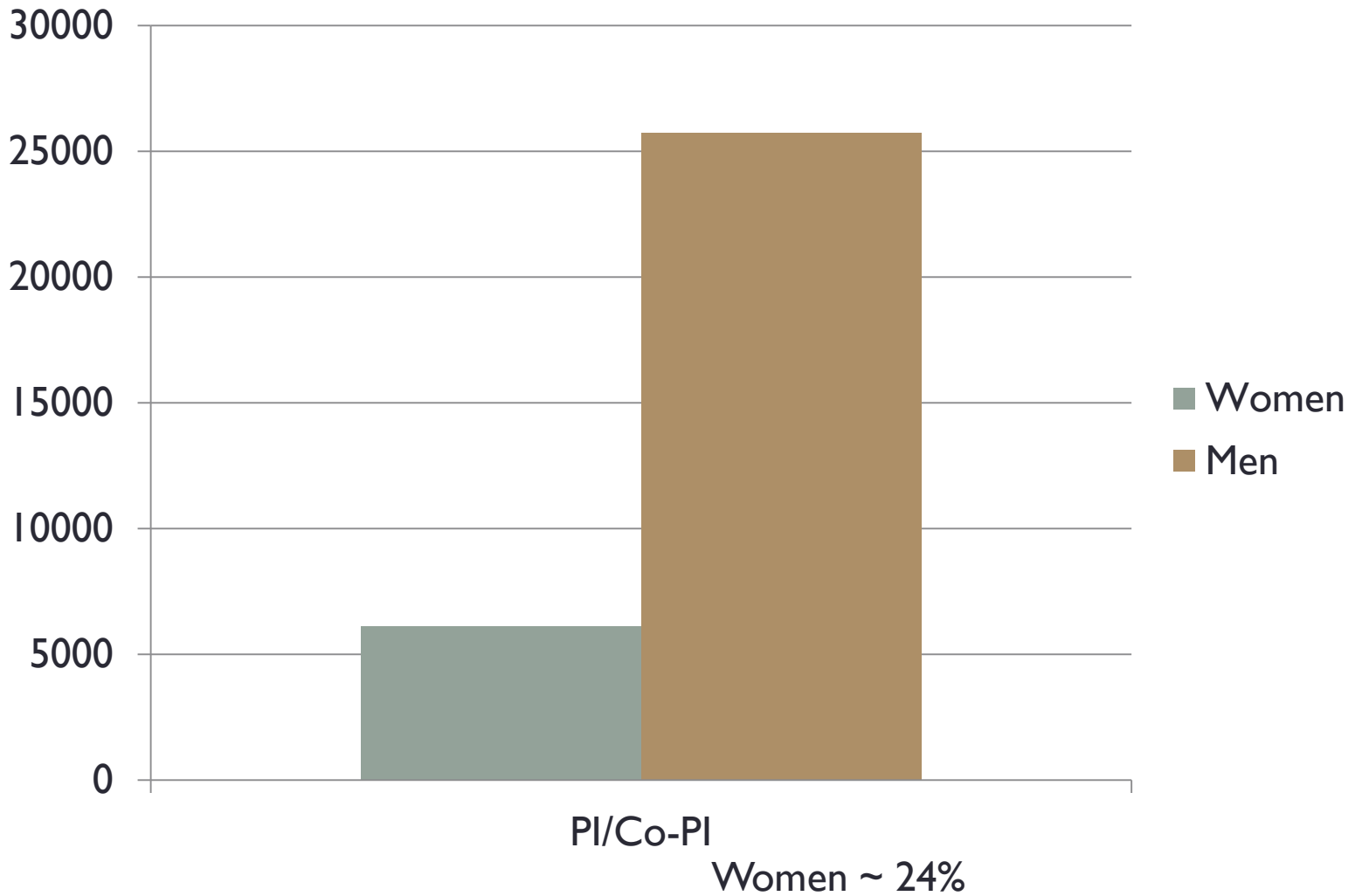

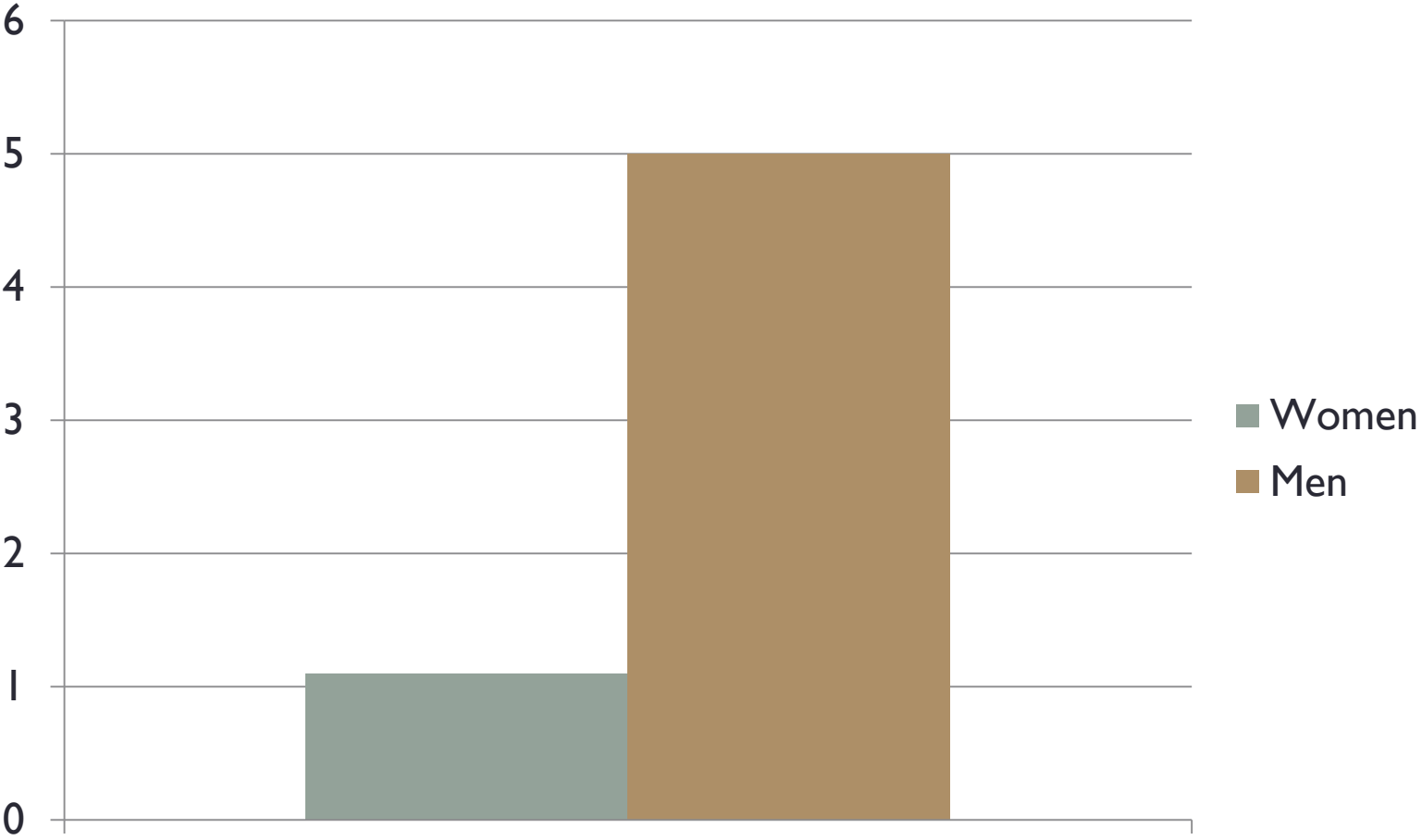

Number of investigators



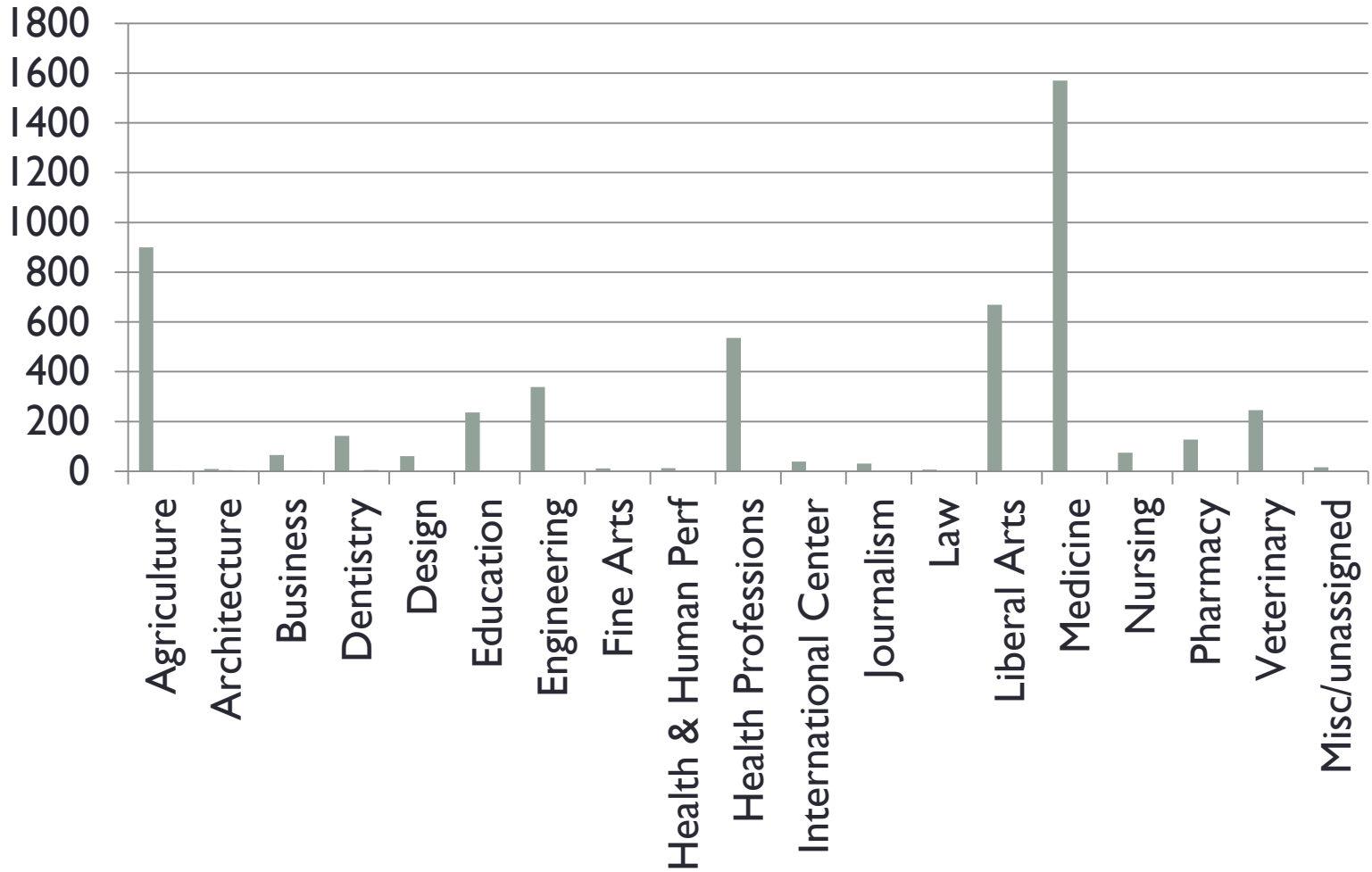

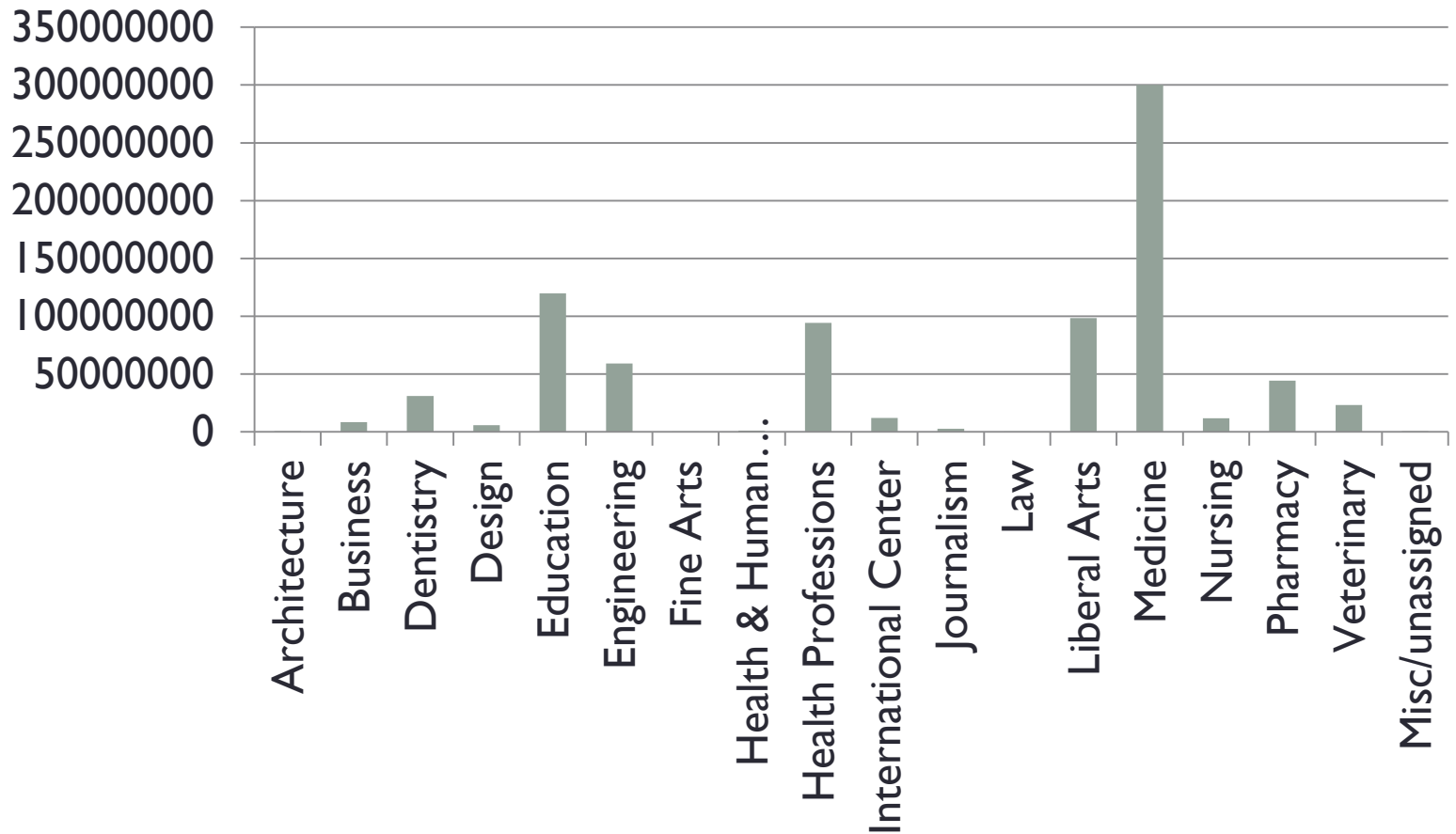

# Distribution of women PI and Co-PIs across colleges



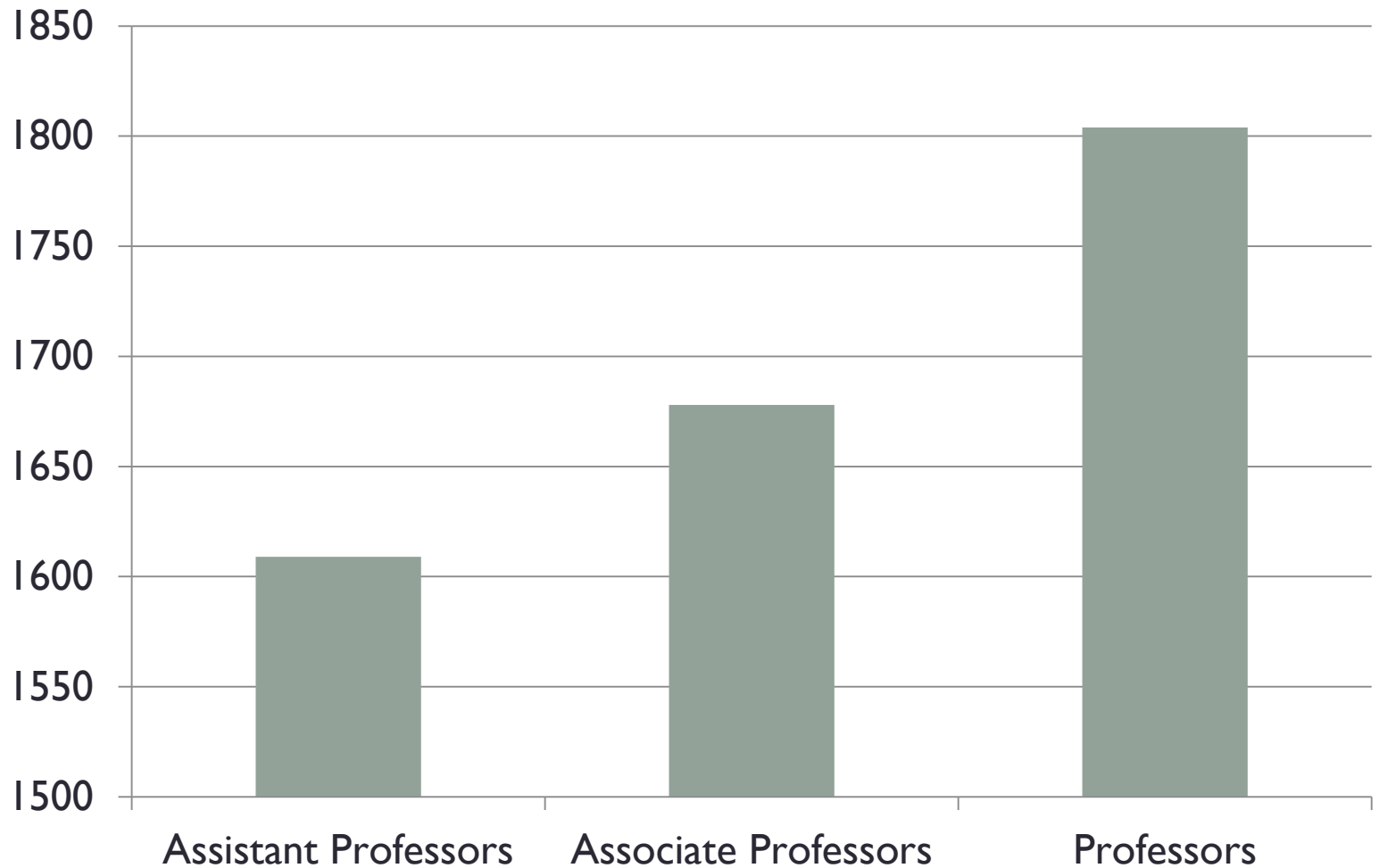

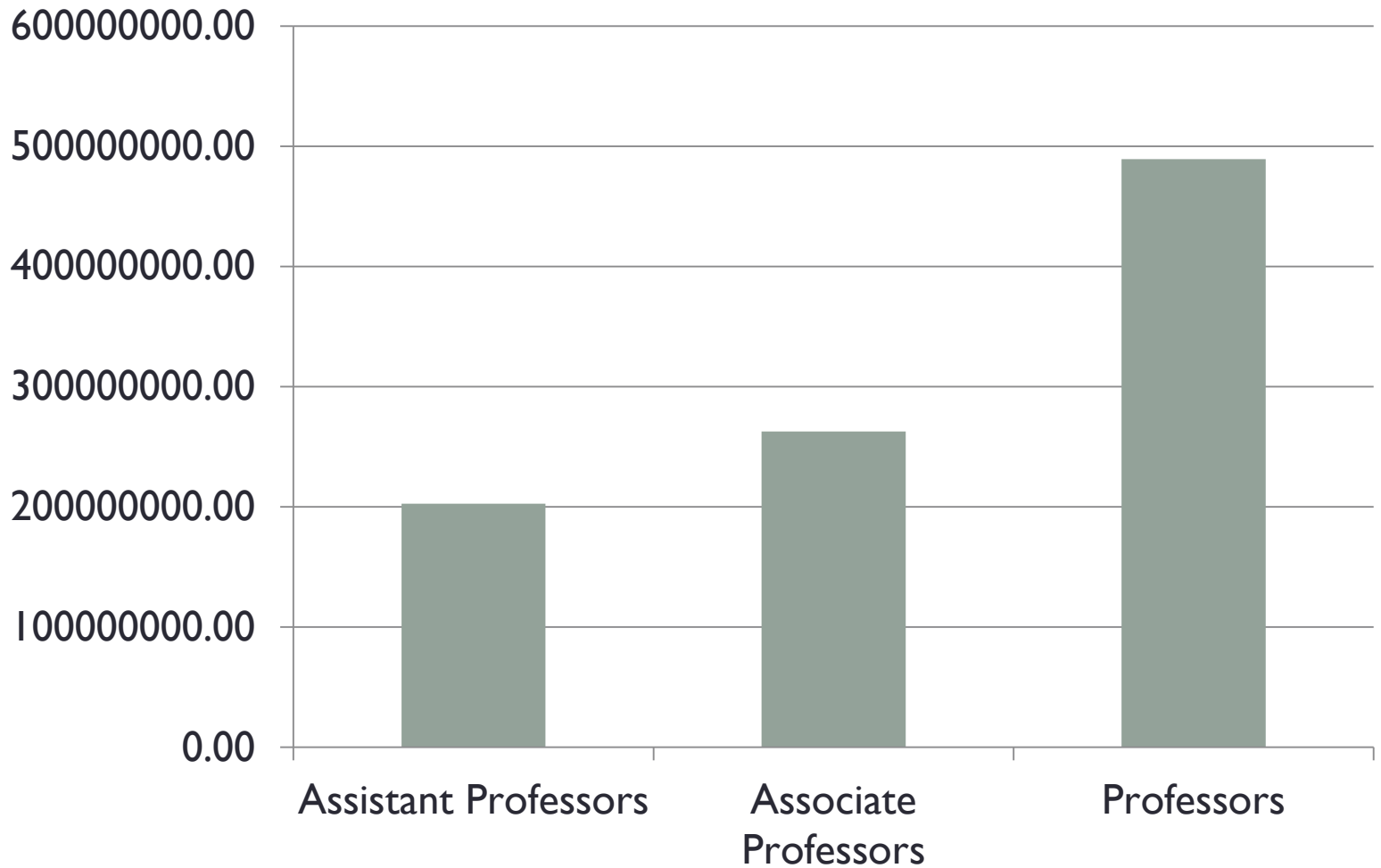




# Number of funded women faculty across ranks
