UF Open Access Publishing Fund, 2017-2019 Summary

Overview

The University of Florida Open Access Publishing Fund, supported through an annual commitment from the Provost's Office for four years in 2017-2020, incentivizes faculty, students, and research staff to publish journal articles in open venues available for anyone to read and share worldwide, without charge. The UFOAP Fund subsidizes costs for article processing charges (APCs), fees that support open access publication by offsetting costs journals have traditionally received from institutional subscriptions.

While not all open access journals charge such fees, many journals have turned to a fee-based model. Other major public research universities with an open access fund include UC-Berkeley, UC-Davis, and Indiana University-Bloomington, among others.

Overseen by the University Libraries Committee and managed by Libraries faculty, the UFOAP fund awarded grants resulting in publication of 336 open access, peer-reviewed research articles from 2017 to 2019. These articles are now freely accessible in a range of publications, including prestigious journals such as *Nature Communications* and the *Journal of Dairy Science*.

Building from a pilot conducted in 2010-2012, the current program has benefited from increased faculty and graduate student awareness of open access and has seen very strong demand. The initial Provost's grant of \$120,000 in 2017, plus \$100,000 additional funding later in the year (\$220,000 total), funded 144 awards. In 2018, \$120,000 led to 78 total awards, with 66 additional applications denied due to lack of funding. Lower caps on award amounts (from \$3,000 in 2017 down to \$1,500 in 2019) and stricter eligibility requirements for those receiving external grants ensured availability of funds through much of the 2019 calendar year. However, in 2019 the maximum award allowed by the fund was only able to cover the full journal fee for 32 percent of awardees.

The following tables summarize the program's first three years, with a focus on breaking down data across colleges and departments.
