

SEC Football Gameday Parking

Alabama

Charge for general public parking? Yes, on-campus parking is sold as season passes or individual games. Season passes are \$175 and are sold from the UA parking website as a printable PDF – customers tear off one ticket with barcode for each game and the barcodes are scanned at the lots using handheld devices (same ones they use for writing tickets).

Individual game parking ranges from \$30-20 per vehicle depending on the lot location. Payment is collected in cash or with credit card scanned using handhelds. Total number of cars is entered on handheld and tracked for accounting purposes.

There are two staff members at each lot, one to scan tickets and one to take money, plus 5-10 temporary staff members (usually local Boy Scouts hired for the day) who direct traffic and park cars.

Off-campus there is a 400-space facility downtown that is free to park with \$1/person shuttle service.

Gameday parking program started approx. 6 years ago at \$10 per car and has risen to current pricing over that period.

Arkansas

Charge for GP parking? NO, but GP parking is only allowed off-campus. All parking on-campus is reserved for boosters (called Scholarship Parking) and minimum cost for season permit is \$750 (going up to \$1000 next year).

There are various off-campus, private parking areas with different fees for parking.

Auburn

Charge for GP parking? Yes for areas close to stadium – Athletic Dept. contracts with AAA Parking to handle gameday parking. Cost is \$120 for season pass or \$25-35 per game depending on location. Season pass is sold online and mailed out, gameday parking is cash only.

There are several lots farther away from the stadium which allow free GP parking and have shuttle service running to them. This service is free to fans and the Athletic Dept. pays for it.

Georgia

Charge for GP parking? There are 4 pay decks (garages) close to the stadium which are available at a cost of \$140 for a season pass. Season passes are sold online and mailed to the customer. Unsold spaces in these garages are sold to fans on gameday at \$20/vehicle, cash only.

There are three decks on the East Campus which are free for parking.

Kentucky

Charge for GP parking? There are four free parking garages approximately .8-1 mile from the stadium, and one pay parking garage approximately .3 mile from the stadium. The cost for the pay facility is \$20/vehicle, and it opens for cash payments 4 hours before kickoff.

Gameday parking facilities are first come, first serve.

LSU

Charge for GP parking? There are two free grass lots on the outskirts of campus. All other non-reserved (booster) campus parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis at a cost of \$40/vehicle with an additional \$10 fee for a trailer.

Parking sales run from noon-8 PM on Friday before the game and from 4 AM – kickoff or until capacity is reached on gameday. Friday sales are handled at the baseball stadium ticket office and are taken by credit card or cash, and Saturday sales are handled at the individual parking areas and are cash-only.

Mississippi State

Charge for GP parking? Yes, there are several grass lots on campus used for gameday GP parking at \$20/vehicle. Payments are cash-only at lots and are first-come, first-serve.

All other parking on campus is reserved for boosters and athletic association use.

Missouri

Charge for GP parking? There are seven parking garages and two lots available for GP parking on gameday – both lots and the two garages closest to the stadium (<.5 mile) are pay facilities at \$25/car. The remaining five garages are free. Payments are taken on-site and are cash-only, and the facilities are all first-come, first serve. There is also a family-friendly (alcohol-free) lot at the VA hospital near the stadium – this lot is also \$25/car and is first-come, first-serve.

Ole Miss

Charge for GP parking? Handled through Athletic Association – unsuccessful in attempts to contact for information. Website states that there are five free GP lots and three pay lots. Cost for pay lots ranges from \$15-20.

Tennessee

Charge for GP parking? No, GP parking is not allowed on campus. All campus parking is reserved for athletic/alumni donors by permit only.

GP parking is available for \$5/car at the Knoxville Civic Auditorium approximately 1 mile from stadium with shuttle service provided by Knoxville Area Transit for \$6/person.

Texas A&M

Charge for GP parking? GP parking on gameday is available for \$20 (one garage), \$15 (two garages), and \$10 (one garage, 15 lots). Price increases the closer that the parking area is located to the stadium. Payments are cash-only at the parking facilities, and all parking is first-come, first-serve.

Vanderbilt

Charge for GP parking? There is one pay garage located within approximately 5 minutes walking distance from the stadium. Parking is available in this garage for \$10/vehicle and is cash only and first-come, first-serve.

There are two free parking garages approximately 15-20 minutes walking distance from the stadium. All other campus parking is reserved for boosters.
