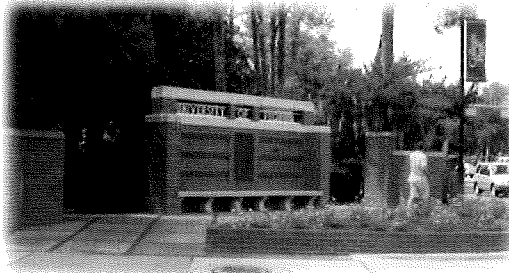


# The "Gateway" to Campus at University Avenue and SW 13<sup>th</sup> Street A TOWN HALL MEETING

**WHEN:** Monday, January 28, 2013

**WHERE:** Bryan Hall, Room 130

**PURPOSE:** Heavener Hall, a new home for undergraduate business students near the corner of University Avenue and SW 13<sup>th</sup> Street, is being designed. Given the historic and symbolic importance of this area, this presents an exciting opportunity to improve the surrounding landscape, including open space connections to the south and west, and the corner pedestrian "gateway" that offers visitors and passers-by a first impression of the UF campus.



Concurrent with design of the new building itself, initial concepts for this area have been developed by the Heavener Hall designers, but broader feedback from the University community is needed to ensure the new "gateway" meets the programmatic goal of "creating a more open and welcoming entry to campus and providing places for people to stop, sit, and enjoy."
