Search consultant, Jan Greenwood, reports there is a lot of excitement and interest in UF and the President's position among leaders of AAU and other major research universities.



We don't have the applicant pool yet, but it is expected to develop quickly once enough interested and qualified people decide to apply.



In the meantime, the Campus Interview Subcommittee is going to meet soon—we hope next week—to review and finalize a proposal to reach out to faculty and other stakeholders for proposed questions for candidates—tied to the approved criteria—that they would like the Search Committee to consider.



Subject to the Subcommittee's review, faculty will be asked to send their proposed questions to the Faculty Senate. The College Faculty Council Committee will review them, identify the most frequently asked questions related to the criteria, and provide them to Jodi Gentry as the faculty proposed questions.



Subject to the Subcommittee review of the proposal, proposed questions from all stakeholders will be assembled and a report will be provided to the Search Committee. The report will include the most prevalent themes and questions of faculty, of students, and of alumni, donors, boosters, business and community leaders.



The Search Committee will be asked to use this input to develop their questions and recommend some questions to the Trustees
