- Does not advocate for the faculty member or the university
- Is not a part of the administration
- Is free from influence in addressing issues of conflict

The Ombuds follows standards of practice articulated by the International Ombudsman Association

- Listen to questions and concerns
- Help to identify and evaluate options
- Offer an impartial perspective
- Make informal inquiries to gather relevant information
- Make referrals to appropriate resources
- Explain relevant UF Regulations
- Recommend constructive change in University policy

The UF Ombuds does not:

- Mediate and negotiate settlements in disputes
- Offer psychological counseling
- Get involved in fact finding
- Represent faculty in a grievance procedure
- Intervene in a formal grievance procedure
- Overturn decisions by university officials
