- President Fuchs and Tom Mitchell, Vice President of UF Advancement, presented an update on the \$3 billion "Go Greater" capital campaign.
  - To improve stature as a top-five public university and one of the top-20 public and private universities
  - The university cannot realize its potential by relying solely on tuition and taxpayer support.
  - o Goal is to establish 200 new endowed chairs/professorships.
  - o Kickoff will be in October 2017.

# **Recommended Constitutional Language**

## For Faculty IT Committee

**Richard Scholtz,** Member Constitution Committee

- The Faculty IT Committee was approved by the Senate in May 2016. Constitution Committee recommends the following language to add to the Constitution:
  - University Information Technology Committee. The University Information Technology Committee shall be composed of eighteen voting members, one member from the University Libraries, one member from the Florida Museum, and one from each of the sixteen colleges. Voting members will serve three-year terms and shall be nominated by action of the respective faculty assembly. Faculty members of all ranks are eligible for membership. The Chair is elected by the Committee and will serve a one-year term. The University Chief Information Officer and two appointees of same, shall serve as liaisons to the Committee. Three non-voting student members shall be chosen for one-year terms: one by the Student Government, one by the Graduate Student Council, and one from one of the professional colleges, rotating between the colleges on an annual basis. The Committee shall assist University leaders in developing and updating strategic plans for information and communications technology. The Committee shall advise the Faculty Senate on all information and communications technology, including those matters affecting the University. The Chief Information Officer or her or his designated liaison shall present matters of policy to the Committee in a timely manner, provide the Committee with pertinent details about information and communications technology network policy changes, and report to the Committee on actions taken in response to the Committee's recommendations.
